BS & BFA Dance Major Program Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Present a minimum high school grade point average of 2.75.
2. Be admitted to Wayne State University.
3. Submit SAT or ACT scores prior to the audition date.
4. Submit the completed Department of Dance application form by **January 1st, 2010** to:

5. Applicants must take a competitive audition class in basic modern and ballet technique on **Jan. 15, 2010 OR Feb. 26, 2010**. The audition will be held in room 3315 Old Main Bldg. (Dance Studio A) at **11:45 a.m.** **Arrive at 11:00 a.m. in order to sign-in.**
6. Perform a solo (3 minute maximum) in a style of the applicant's choice at the time of audition.
Out of state applicants may submit a video.

Talent Scholarship

Applicants selected for the Talent Scholarship in Dance will receive a scholarship of \$4240/year for the entire four years of their program. Talent Award recipients and Dance students accepted into the program will be notified by **March 19, 2010**.

Talent Award recipients must meet the following criteria:

- A. Be a full time student at WSU for eight (8) consecutive semesters carrying 12-16 credit hours during Fall and Winter terms.
- B. Be in the Dance Major Program and a member of one of the WSU Dance Companies for 8 consecutive semesters.
- C. Maintain a 2.5 G.P.A. overall and a 3.0 G.P.A. in dance courses at WSU.
- D. Register for DNC 5800: Dance Repertory in Winter Term 2010
- E. Audition for all Guest Artist Residencies in the Dance Department

Students who experience difficulty with the above criteria will be placed on probation and could lose the Talent Scholarship. For information call Raymond Robinson at (313) 577-4273.
